Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. Entries must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Signature requirement must be waived on all deliveries. If applicable, limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard. Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries.**

“After Closing” Waiting List

A waiting list (25 run maximum each day) will be maintained from closing until Monday, August 2, 2021, 6:00pm CDT. Any dogs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials.** Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the AKC Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Tentative Running Order

Electronic Timing will be used.

Check-in begins at 3:00 pm and judging to start at 4:00 pm on Friday.

Check-in begins at 8:00 am and judging to start at 9:00 am on Saturday.

Walk-through approximately 30 minutes before judging begins.

Class Order – Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

Friday: T2B, Premier Std., Premier JWW

Saturday: Premier JWW, Premier Std., Premier Cup Finals

Running Order: Short to Tall all days

Prizes and Awards

Premier and Time 2 Beat:

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs qualifying in each jump height class. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 4th place finishes in each jump height class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. AGCH ribbons and bars will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH, title at these trials.

Prizes specific to the Premier Cup Special Event are listed on pages 6-7.

All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show.

No ribbons, etc., will be mailed after the show.

Volunteering for ring crew makes the trial move quicker!

Workers will receive an admission ticket and parking pass into the Illinois State Fairgrounds if you are not entered in the trials.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height divisions. Judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. Height divisions are as follows:

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form if your dog needs measured. For more information please visit http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm**

SITE INFORMATION:

The trial will be held in an indoor packed dirt arena. 1 ring, 100' x 100' in size will be used. *Crating space will be available. There will be a food concession at the trial site. There are several restaurants and fast food places within driving distance*

RV Hookups

NO RV hookups are available on the Illinois State Fairgrounds.

Trial Information

The building will be open Friday afternoon August 13, 2021, for course building. Times will be announced after closing. Volunteers who assist in setting up the rings may set up their crates after course building is completed. Trial hours on Friday are: 3:00 pm until 9:00 pm on Friday evening when all dogs must be removed from the Illinois State Fairgrounds. Security will be available for the crating area until 9:00 pm Friday evening in the coliseum. Trial hours on Saturday are 7:00 am until 2:00 pm on Saturday when all dogs must be removed. The coliseum is not climate controlled. It does have indoor restrooms and bleacher seating. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies. Xpens will be allowed for 2 or more dogs but should be restricted to the minimum size required for crating.

Notice to Exhibitors

***The safety** of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

***It is expressly** understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case no refund of any fees paid will be made.

***No entry fee** will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Committee.

***All dogs** must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

***Exhibitors** are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

***Entries** must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form. **Include only AKC titles on form.**

***Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.**

***Owners** are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

***Since bitches in season** are not allowed to compete in this trial the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive notification (phone or email) of such a claim for refund as soon as possible along with a confirmation letter from a veterinarian.

***Entry fees** will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee or the judge.

***The club** will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for injured or ill dogs. Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

***Dogs under 4 months** of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

***Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

*** All owners of mixed breed dogs** must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.

***Exhibitors** are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

No un-entered dogs are permitted with 30" of the ring barriers.

CCTC, their Board and Members, and the Illinois State Fairgrounds and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

***Capitol Canine Training Club** does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

We will not be offering FEO at this trial.

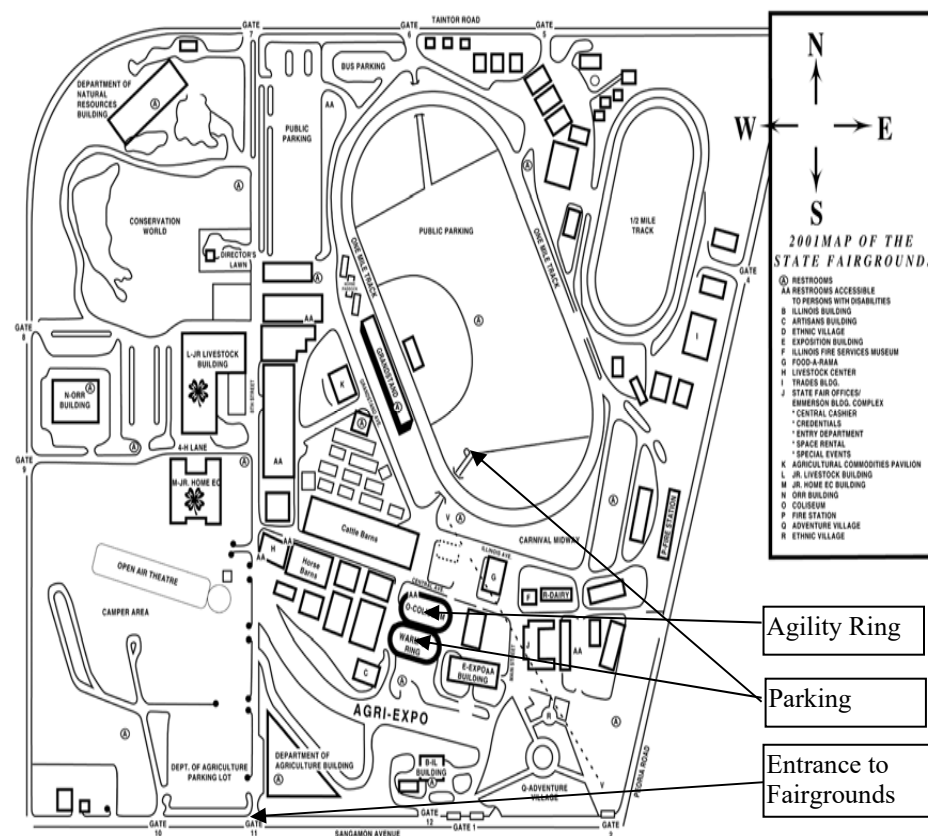

1st Annual Illinois State Fair Premier Cup



JOIN IN THE FUN AT THIS SPECIAL AGILITY EVENT!

WHAT IS THE ILLINOIS STATE FAIR PREMIER CUP?

A tournament event offering Cash prizes. Competitors enter and run four (4) Premier classes (2 PJWW and 2 PSTD) offered over the two days to be qualified to win cash prizes. The individual dog's combined results from all four premier runs will be used to determine overall tournament placements based on score by jump height. Participation in the Illinois State Fair Premier Cup is optional for any exhibitor at the trial.

WHO CAN ENTER

Any dog that meets the eligibility requirements set by AKC may participate in this Special Event. No prerequisites or qualifications are necessary.

AWARDS

Normal awards will be given out for all jump heights in the Premier classes. They will be awarded rosettes for 1-4 in regular and preferred classes.

Premier Cup Awards

The top 5 dogs from each jump height will compete in a finals run that will be a premier jumpers hybrid that will include one contact either a teeter or A-Frame. Top placements for scored heights 8", 12", 16", 20" and 24" will receive a tournament award. Cash prizes and rosette ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place winners. (Preferred classes will compete against Regular class in what would be their normal jump height ie: 4" preferred will compete against 8" regular, 8" preferred will compete against 12" regular etc., for placements)

PRIZE CALCULATION

Cash prizes will be distributed based on a weighted percentage of dogs entered within each of the five (5) scored height divisions – thus more prize money shall be awarded to height(s) with the most entrants. Within the weighted percentage of each scored height 1st place shall be awarded 50%, 2nd place 20% and 3rd place 15% and 4th place 10% and 5th place 5%.

Example: We will be taking \$25 of those that have entered all four of the premier classes to put in the pool. So, if there are five 8", ten 12", twelve 16", twenty 20" and three 24" the cash pool would be 50 entrants x \$25 = \$1,875

SCORING:

Each premier run will first be scored per AKC Regulations. For tournament placements only, an additional score will be calculated on a Time Plus Faults Equals Score model. Dog's Run Time plus Course Faults shall result in Score. Five (5) course faults will be assessed for each Refusal, Wrong Course, and Failure to Perform. SCT x 2 shall be assessed for an Excusal (i.e. whistle). Each of the four scores of all the dog's premier runs, both standard and JWW, will be added together to achieve a final tournament score. Final placements will be determined by the lowest cumulative score, per scored jump height. For tournament placements only, dogs will be scored and placed based on their regular jump height. Example: a 4" preferred dog will jump 4", but be scored and placed with the 8" jump height division; dogs at 24C will be scored with the 20" jump height division (assuming the dog's measured jump height is 20").

HOW TO ENTER

Participants must enter and run all four (4) Premier classes (2 PJWW and 2 PSTD) 2-day trial. Indicate participation on the official entry form.

FOR ONLINE ENTRIES: Participants wishing to be included in the Illinois State Fair Premier Cup must enter all four Premier Classes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
