MEASURING: Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

CLASSES: All Standard, JWW both days and Premier Standard and Premier JWW on Saturday. T2B on Sunday.. There will be no FAST, ISC; classes at this trial. Electronic timers will be used

ENTRY FEE is \$22.00 for the first entry(includes AKC recording fees of \$3.50), and \$18.00 for each additional class of the same dog, per day (with recording fees of \$3.50 for the 2nd entry).

Mail entries, maximum of 10 per envelope, (with fees payable to CDA) to Nancy Youngen, 510 Maple Ave, Maple Park, Il 60151. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned in their entirety. Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to insufficient funds will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms, or those with insufficient entry fees, will be returned, no attempts by email or phone will be made!

Notification of entry status prior to closing will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or postcard to be returned with their entry status information. No other acknowledgement of entry status will be given! Exhibitors with email addresses are responsible for making sure their email address is legible and that any mail from the trial secretary is not blocked by spam blockers or rejected due to a full mailbox. No further attempt will be made.

Final entry confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 18 of the Regulations for Agility trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmations, exhibitors with no email address will be sent their confirmation via the US Postal Service.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. A PAX ribbon and MACH / PACH bar and ribbon will be awarded to any dog and handler earning their PAX or MACH/PACH title at this event. No ribbons or prizes will be mailed.

WAIT LIST: This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time of April 12 at 6:00 p.m. Any entries withdrawn by Sunday April 21, 2024 at 10:00 p.m. will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry not moved off waitlist by closing will have their entry shredded.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Any bitch that comes into season after the closing date may have their entry fee returned, less \$5.00 per entry administrative fee without any veterinarian documentation. Any dog injured after closing date may have entry fee returned, less \$5.00 per entry by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins. Refunds for entries may be up to the discretion of the trial committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging, however handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors are required by the state of Illinois to maintain proof of either rabies vaccination or titer.

All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the designated agility warm-up area.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at Car-Dun-Al's training facility, 10783 Wolf Drive, Huntley, IL. The training center is in the southwest corner of the second building on the right. It will be indoors on ³/₄' agility matting. There will be no barking dogs allowed in vehicles, they must be crated inside. Fast food restaurants are nearby. Any additional questions regarding the site and the amenities should be directed to the trial chairman.

Directions to the site are as follows:

From the East or West on I-90: Exit Route 47 (electronic I-PASS only) Go north on Route 47 approximately 3.7 miles to Oakcrest Drive and turn left (known as Algonquin Road to the right). Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) UPDATED

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.
