

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES AFTER THE CLOSING DATE/TIME

A waiting list will be kept until Friday, April 5, 2024, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry <u>if any are available</u>. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email.
- Hand delivered entries will not be accepted for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.
- Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Mail requiring signature will be returned to sender – NO EXCEPTIONS.

- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4).
- Move-ups (Prior to set of trials): Accepted until 6:00 pm, Monday, August 8, 2024.
- Move-ups (Day-to-Day): AAGKC will accept day-to-day move-ups. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than 30 minutes after the end of the days trial.

AKC Jump Height Cards - Effective 1/1/10

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs (except those jumping 24" or 26") without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run.

• You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry.

• You are required to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees less \$10 administrative fee and applicable AKC recording fees per day will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf. Ring size will be 105' x 98'.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with conflicts and/or multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings, may walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent, and are encouraged to do so.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each regular titling class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

Rosettes will be awarded to all dogs completing a title. Double-Q Rosettes will be awarded to any dog qualifying in both rings (Std and JWW) in the same class. Commemorative MACH or PACH ribbons and bars will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH or PACH title at these trials. PAX Rosettes will be awarded to any dog finishing a PAX title at these trials. The Club will offer a rosette and bar for dogs earning the Agility Grand Champion title.

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each non-regular class (ISC). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No
 one shall have any recourse or claim against Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City or any official thereof.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Please limit the use of flexi-leads to exercising dogs outdoors.
- Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- Covid Restrictions which will be followed at the trial can be found on the secretary website for this trial at <u>DoRightSecretary.com</u>.

REFUNDS

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees less \$10 administrative fee and applicable AKC recording fees per day will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.

RINGSIDE

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging whether they have a height card or not. As of March 1, 2022 if a VMO or Agility Field Representative is measuring dogs at a trial, all present and entered dogs without a valid measurement must be measured. Until further notice, Judges of Record who are not VMOs will not measure dogs.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- **<u>BUILDING</u>**: The building is climate controlled; indoor restrooms.
- <u>BUILDING SET-UP INFORMATION</u>: THE BUILDING WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR GENERAL SET-UP ON THURSDAY. The building will open at 7:00 a.m. Friday morning.
- <u>CRATES</u> may be left overnight; however, Agility Ability of Greater Kansas City will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. No dogs allowed overnight in the building. Indoor crating is available in a climate-controlled crating room on the south side of ASDS. Crating might be a little tight at the site, so please conserve space by using wire crates and stacking crates whenever possible. Mats must be placed under the crate, chair and any other furniture set up in an exhibitors area. Also, please leave the area along the tree line on the south side of the parking lot for exhibitors crating out of their vehicles. More information about crating set-up will be included in the confirmation letter.
- Electronic Timing: Electronic timing will be used at these trials.
- <u>PARKING</u>: There is close parking, but please park conservatively. Please reserve parking along the south tree line for exhibitors crating out of vehicles.
- RV PARKING:
 - Overnight RV parking is not allowed at the trial site.
 - o Limited daytime parking is allowed for small RVs. Please contact Janel Davidson, 816-853-8152.
 - There are RV parks in close proximity to the show site in the Jackson County Parks System at <u>Blue Springs Lake</u> and <u>Lake Jacomo</u>. The Jackson County online registration page for campgrounds can be located by clicking <u>here</u>. There are also private RV parks in Grain Valley, Oak Grove, and Odessa.
- FOOD: Please feel free to bring in outside food. There will be lunch and drinks available for workers. There are fast food and sit-down restaurants within close driving distance.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

- Please be aware that some navigation devices do not know the correct location for All Star Dog Sports. It is advised that you look at a map and find the location before trusting your phone or GPS.
- The site is **located** south of the city of Blue Springs on Highway 7, just south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Rd, on the west side of Hwy 7.
- If you are coming from the north (I-70), it is 4.8 miles south of the intersection of I-70 and Hwy 7 and immediately past Anderson Rentals.`
- If you are coming from the south, it is 1.4 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Colbern Rd. or 5.3 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Hwy 50 and north of the Storage Mart storage facility. Hwy 7 is divided by a median so it will be necessary to drive north of the site and make a U-turn at Wyatt Road.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel and grounds are considered within the trial limits. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the motel/adjoining grounds will be brought to the attention of the show giving club and it's Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020 exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entering in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the first run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On will be supported at this trial.

Fix and Go On is being offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give the AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather it occurs during the course of the run.

For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO will be supported at this trial.

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

COMMON ISC QUESTIONS

- Who can enter ISC?
 - Anyone who wants to try it. There are no restrictions on what levels you can enter in ISC and how many classes you enter on a single day. If you want to enter all ISC runs on Friday you may.
- Does my dog have to jump at their ISC jump height?
 - No. You can enter your dog in regular or preferred at the height they normally jump in AKC. However runs at AKC jump heights will not count toward EOTT qualifications.
- How do ISC courses compare with other AKC courses?
 - ISC courses generally have more space between obstacles than other AKC courses. Most ISC courses
 designed by FCI judges have a really nice flow for the dogs but can be challenging for the handlers. In general,
 ISC level 1 courses have about the same level of difficulty as AKC Open courses. ISC level 2 courses have
 about the same difficulty as AKC Ex/Master courses but may include some Premier elements. In general, ISC
 level 3 courses are more difficult than courses offered in regular AKC trials.
- How is ISC judged?
 - ISC is judged using FCI rules. A summary of the scoring system is included in Chapter 14 of the "AKC Regulations for Agility Trials, Non-Regular Agility Classes International Sweepstakes Class".
- How are the runs scored?
 - Faults, then time.
- What are Faults in ISC?
 - Course Time Penalties are one (1) fault for each full second over Standard Course Time
 - Standard (S) faults incur a five (5) point penalty and include
 - A displaced bar, plank, or displaceable surface that the dog was to jump over
 - Missed contact zones (including the upside zone of the A-Frame).
 - Seesaw fly-off
 - Early table departure
 - Skipped weave pole after entered correctly
 - Moving or stepping on top of the Broad Jump
 - Breaking apart the Tire Jump
 - Refusal (R) faults incur a five (5) point penalty and include:
 - Refusal at any obstacle
 - Run out at any obstacle
 - Dog exiting a contact obstacle prior to starting its descent on that obstacle.
 - Failure to enter the Weave Poles properly
 - Elimination Faults
 - Three (3) refusals and/or run-outs on a course
 - Dog running the wrong course, including touching the wrong obstacle with one (1) paw.
 - Dog/handler contact that aids the performance of the dog
 - Handler contact with the equipment if it aids or was intended to aid the performance of the dog
 - Outside assistance to the handler/dog in the ring that aided the performance
 - Failure to complete all the obstacles on the course.
