The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Equipment and Obstacles

Equipment is provided by Power Paws Agility. Obstacles will meet the specifications for ISC classes in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility.

Fee Schedule

Entry fee: \$22 for the first entry of a dog; \$22 for each additional entry of the same dog per day

Awards

Qualification (clean run) ribbons will not be awarded at this trial unless requested.

Additionally, other awards will be given to top finishers in the Power Paws Cup A3 course (last course Sunday). Details about those awards and eligibility will be described below.

Food and Beverages

There will not be any food or beverage provided at the site. Please bring your own food with you. Lunch will be provided for Key Workers.

For Exhibition Only (FEO) allowed at this trial

- For Exhibition Only will be offered. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
 Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay
 class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for
 that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is unable to obtain a qualifying score.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge

Bitches in Season (BIS)

BIS will be permitted to compete at this event. Handlers with bitches in season are requested to indicate on the run order prior to their run and take appropriate precautions to minimize disruption.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

- Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.
- FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's
 performance of an obstacle is not to expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle
 then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score

Qualifications

"Clean run" scores from ISC Classes at official FCI jump heights 12", 16", 20 and 24" may be used to fulfill the qualification requirements for WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults.

Jump Heights

Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2023 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- Small (12" jump height) for dogs measuring 13 3/4" or less at the withers
- Medium (16" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 13 3/4" and up to 16 7/8" at the withers
- Intermediate (20" jump height) for dogs measuring more than 16 7/8 but less than 18 7/8" at the
 withers
- Large (24" jump height) for dogs measuring over 18 7/8" at the withers

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warm up jump will be provided on grass.

Volunteers

Trials cannot happen without the help of volunteers. If you have time to set a bar, run a leash, time, scribe or gate – even if it is only for ten dogs – it will help immensely. We will break up running into two halves per class so that workers in either half will have time to warm up their dog before they are set to run in the next half.

Flower Power Cup - International Sweepstakes Classes (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard (Agility) and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (http://www.akc.org).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to all dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC: dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping their regular height. For example: 16" preferred dogs will be scored against 20" regular division dogs. Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC. At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the information in this premium list may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.



Flower Power Cup Winners in the A3 Final (last class Sunday)

The ISC Agility 3 (ISC A3) Final class on Sunday can be entered by anyone, however only certain teams can win the Flower Power Cup based on their score in Sunday's A3 ISC Agility class. In order to be eligible to win the Flower Power Cup, teams:

- Must be entered in at least one of the ISC classes other than Sunday's ISC A3 Final Class
- Must be entered in the Sunday ISC A3 Final class
- Must (a) finish one of the previous ISC runs in the top 40% of their jump height as scored on a faults then time basis, (b) finish under the Standard Course Time (SCT) defined by the judge of record, and (c) not have a result of an "E" as defined as going off course or accumulating three or more refusals in the run

There will be a podium for the top three finishers in each height in the Sunday ISC A3 final class out of the competitors satisfying the above criteria.

Placements for the Flower Power Cup Finals will be based on individual scores in the final class, as scored on a Faults then Time basis. Eligible scores will be under SCT and not have a result of an "E" as described above.

First place finishers in each height will receive a special prize which is TBD. Second and third place finishers MAY also receive special prizes but that is TBD. There may be other prizes awarded, please follow the Facebook page for the Flower Power Cup for further details.

NOTE: Since the Sunday ISC A3 final class can be entered by ANYONE, a "Clean Run" in the class can be used for WTT/EOTT qualifications as defined by the rules for WTT/EOTT

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with
 the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative
 Listing /Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs
 provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form. Exceptions: bitches in
 season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may
 affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dog separated as much as possible
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of the reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, weather, an act of God, an act of Mother Nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee
- Refunds are sent 7 days after the event
- Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry
- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the Ring or when in the designated agility/warm up areas
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up or off-leash areas
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box
