MEASURING AND AKC JUMP HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary Jump Height Card issued by the AKC must be measured prior to competing. If a measurement is necessary, it will be the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Saturday and Sunday trials are open to all AKC recognized breeds; Monday's trial is the DPCA National trial and is open to Doberman Pinschers only. Dogs must be fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a groomed dirt surface. Ring size will be 100'x100'.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Please put DPCA on the outside of your envelope.** Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20 service fee on all returned checks.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 40% online and 60% paper. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour period, the club reserves the right to increase or decrease either one accordingly.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up area consisting of a regulation agility jump shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space is plentiful. Crates may be left overnight; however, DPCA will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food is available onsite in the convention hall. Coolers are allowed and fast-food restaurants are nearby.

Clean Up - Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal area will be available at the showgrounds.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the trial.

Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Green Qualifying ribbon for each qualifying score.

New title rosettes will be awarded at both the Regional and the National trials.

All 1st-4th awards for Standard and Jumpers classes only

Highest Scoring Doberman with double qualifying scores from REGULAR Excellent or Master Standard and JWW: Each day for the Doberman with the fastest combined YPS (yards per second), the Doberman Pinscher Club of America offers a Rosette and 13 inch Doberman Silhouette. If there is no double qualifier, award will be presented to fastest scoring Doberman in the Standard class. Doberman Pinschers only will receive a set of 2 stone coasters with National logo for 1st through 4th place in Standard and JWW classes.

All-breed entries will receive flat placement ribbons for 1st-4th place

NATIONAL SPECIALTY TRIAL (Monday 9/28)

Specialty Prizes only in Standard and JWW only.

First Place – Blue Rosette and 11 inch wood Doberman head

Second Place – Red Rosette and 9 inch wood Doberman head

Third Place -- Yellow Rosette and 9 inch wood Doberman head

Fourth Place -- White Rosette and 9 inch wood Doberman head

Highest Scoring Doberman with double qualifying scores from REGULAR Excellent or Master Standard and Regular JWW classes: The Doberman with the fastest combined YPS (yards per second), the Doberman Pinscher Club of America offers a Framed Rosette. If there is no double qualifier, award will be presented to fastest scoring Doberman in the Standard class.

AGCH/MACH/PACH: All dogs finishing a AGCH/MACH/PACH will receive a rosette and bar. If you & your dog are close to a AGCH/MACH/PACH, please let the trial secretary and/or trial chair know.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The DPCA and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The DPCA reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the DPCA or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Pinch collars, electric or dummy collars are prohibited on trial grounds.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund all but \$11 per class of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

No refunds will be made for amounts less than \$5.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

Directions to the trial site:

Approaching from the East

Coming from Kansas City on the turnpike, exit East Topeka (Exit 183). Next, take Exit 363 (Adams Street / Branner Traffic way). Turn left at the stop sign at the bottom of the ramp, go straight to 21st Street and turn right. Go straight to Topeka Blvd., you will see the Kansas Expocentre to your right.

Approaching from the West:

Take Eastbound Interstate-70. Exit at Gage Blvd. (Exit 358B). Proceed south on Gage Blvd to the 21st Street exit. Turn left. Follow eastbound 21st Street 2.27 miles to Topeka Blvd. Turn left onto Topeka Blvd. The main entrance to the Kansas Expocentre will be on your left.

Approaching from the North:

Take new U.S. Highway 75 to East Interstate-70. Exit at Gage Blvd. (Exit 358B). Proceed south on Gage Blvd to the 21st Street exit. Turn left. Follow eastbound 21st Street about two miles to Topeka Blvd. Turn left onto Topeka Blvd. The main entrance to the Kansas Expocentre will be on your left.

Approaching from the South:

Via Kansas Turnpike: Take South Topeka Exit (Exit 177). Immediately after toll booth, take Topeka Blvd. Exit (Exit 6). Turn left onto Topeka Blvd and proceed through 21st Street. You'll be able to see the Kansas Expocentre main entrance on your left.

Via US Highway 75: Take Topeka Ave. Exit. Follow Topeka through the 21st Street intersection. The main entrance to the Kansas Expocentre will be on your left.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
