Online vs Paper Entry Primary Limits:

GRCSL is accepting online entries for this trial through the LabTestedOnline.com service. Go to www.labtestedonline.com and follow the instructions there to use your account to enter this event online. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online entries or paper entries will be as follows: Online Entries: 33% Paper entries: 67%. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limits accordingly.

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- 1) Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- 2) Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- 3) Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

Make checks payable to Triune Agility Club ***(returned check charge is \$23)***. All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4) Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. **Please waive signature on Fed Ex or UPS mail. Mail requiring signatures will be returned to sender. Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours**

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

Measuring and Height Card Information: It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a VMO or an AKC Agility Rep is present; all dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process: When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be measured. Please make sure and check that box if your dog needs to be measured.

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs

suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. All American dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "All American" and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

No professional photography or videotaping is permitted without permission.

NO SMOKING is allowed in the building.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight

These trials will be held indoors on one 100' X 80' ring with rubber surface. Facility is Air conditioned. There is plenty of close parking, crate space and restrooms. Please bring chairs, crates, and water for your dogs and clean up tools.

No strollers or playpens will be allowed in the building.

BUILDING WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SET UP on Thursday from 6:00-7:30p.m. for those willing to help with setup. It will then be available to the all others at 7:00 a.m. on Friday, 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

X-pens for two large dogs or three small dogs will be allowed. There must be a cover over the x-pen. If dogs are lunging you will be asked to crate dogs. Flexi Leads are not allowed in the building or within 50 feet of the building

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Refunds for bitches that come in season and injured dogs after the closing date, will receive a refund minus \$5 per day with a veterinary statement.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$23 charge added on returned checks. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refund of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

The Golden Retriever Club of Greater St. Louis does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
