DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds

Dogs with a PAL/ILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated. **Dogs must be entered in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.**

AKC Jump Height Card

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs (except those jumping 24" or 26") without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run. You are not required to show your height card, or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement. If your dog does not have a valid height card for a trial and is not measured by a VMO, if present, any qualifying runs earned will be disallowed.

Move-ups

MOVE UPS close at 6:00 pm CDT , Monday Sept 28. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Sunday October 4, 2015 Trial: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Saturday October 4 and must be submitted at the trial.

Trial Information

Set-up time for Friday evening will be announced in the confirmation information after closing. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after the completion of judging

Ring size is 140 x 75′ (1 ring). There is Air Conditioned crating inside for your dog. There are ample outdoor areas to exercise your dog(s). Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Food will be available at the site for a nominal donation. There are also restaurants within a 5 mile radius of the building. We will be providing food, snacks and beverages for our workers.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The <u>safety of the dog</u> is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Entry fee will be not refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- The Peoria Obedience Training Club (POTC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **POTC** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the POTC or any official thereof.
- <u>All dogs must be on leash or crated</u> at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.
- Since <u>bitches in season</u> are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive <u>written notification</u> of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmark <u>before the trial commences</u>.
- The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee in the form of a club voucher for exhibitors who are absent due to a death in the immediate family.
- <u>Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.</u> The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. POTC has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and <u>must include the signed</u> <u>Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers</u> must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

- All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. The dog's breed name should be entered as "All American Dog". The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refund for duplicate entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Peoria Obedience Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 return check fee.

Electronic Timing

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Ribbons, Awards, and Prizes

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH & PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH or PACH. Cones will be presented to those dogs attaining their MX/MXP/MXJ/MJP. A dog toy valued at three to five dollars will be will be given to each dog entered <u>per weekend</u>.. Awards must be claimed at the trial; none will be mailed.

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
