#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

All dogs must be kept on leash, except when in the agility ring.

**ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts. Purina Farms is the show site. Puppies under four (4) months are not allowed.

The Event Center will be available to exhibitors at 4:00 PM – 6:00 PM on May 20, 2017.

There will be 6000 square feet of day crating space available in the Great Hall. DCA reserves the right to require that all crating must be stacked. This will be the only area where crating will be permitted. There will be no ringside crating for conformation. Dogs may be crated in the area from 6:00 AM until 6:00 PM on May 21 and from 6:00 AM until 10:00 PM on May 22 - 26.

The show-giving club, the Show Secretary, the land-owners, or Purina Farms assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property.

No dogs allowed in rest rooms, and no washing of animal food containers in rest rooms. Exercise dogs in designated areas only.

No videotaping or photography during the events for resale is permitted without Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. approval.

**Please be advised:** When exhibitors/handlers bring a dog to the podium for a win/ placement photo, they are establishing a de facto contract with the show photographer to purchase that photo.

No grooming allowed in the Great Hall except in the designated crating area. No unentered dogs or puppies allowed in building per AKC guidelines.

No dogs allowed in rings before or after show hours. Dogs are allowed in rings only during judging hours.

No baby strollers are allowed near the ring during show hours.

All AKC Rules and Regulations will be enforced by the Show Event Committee under AKC guidelines. Failure to comply with these rules will result in charges being brought before the Show Event Committee. Any event hearing, disciplinary action, rule violations, complaints, or charges will be resolved by the Dalmatian Club of America, Inc. National Specialty Event Committee. Unless otherwise specified, all trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed, except for those trophies that have been specified herein.

# CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of god, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Secretary.

The show-giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries or as indicated in this document for move-ups. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

**EXHIBITORS NOTE:** Please notify Secretary of any change of address.

Telephone entries and unsigned entries cannot be accepted.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable via email.

An AKC recording fee of \$3.50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Agility Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the trial, the \$3.00 event service fee will be collected on additional entries as well. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

All owners/handlers are responsible for entering their dog(s) in the proper height class.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Dalmatians (5/22/17) and all dogs (5/21/17) 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have an AKC limited registration, or that have obtained an ILP number from AKC, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in agility trials.

PLEASE NOTE: Entry fees minus a \$5 processing fee per run entered in Agility will be refunded when request is accompanied by a certificate from a veterinarian for bitches coming into season after entries close. Notification for refund of bitches in season must be RECEIVED at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the trial.

### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS**

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height division. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

<u>Regular</u> Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

**<u>Preferred</u>** The following jump heights must be used in all Preferred Classes.

Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches

Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretions.

#### **OBSTACLES**

All obstacles used will meet the current specifications as set forth in the AKC Agility Regulations. **RING DESCRIPTION:** This is an indoor arena with specially designed artificial turf. Ring dimensions are 120 x 90 feet. Crating will be available in the crating area ringside during the hours of the trial only.

**NOTICE:** All handlers in AKC must have an official height card for each dog entered or have their dogs measured prior to running in any class excluding those jumping 24", unless there is a VMO or AKC representative in attendance. All dogs without a permanent or temporary height card will have to be measured by the judge before running. However, all exhibitors should carry the original AKC official jump height card with them to each trial in order to present the card upon request.

**Simplified Jump Height Card Process:** When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

**Move-ups** must be received in writing by the Trial Secretary no later than 7 PM, Monday, May 15, 2017 for the Sunday trial. Move-ups for the Monday trial will be permitted on Sunday, May 21 up to 30 minutes following the end of the Sunday trial.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION:** Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without the dogs prior to the start of the class. The walk-through allows handlers to plan their strategy for running the course.

A warm-up area with a regulation jump will be provided.

**EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:** Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by *a* Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
