MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. There will be a VMO at this trial

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in; although exhibitors are required to have the official form/card with them at the trial to present upon request.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Agility Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website at <http://www.akc.org/rules/>.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

All obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. **Rubber contacts will be used for all classes in both Rings.** All classes will take place **indoors** on Soccer turf. Ring size will be 110 x 110. This site is air-conditioned and heated.

Inquiries may be directed to Le Hayes at lehayes3@aol.com . No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Peoria Obedience Training Club is accepting online entries through www.labtestedonline.com During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: Online entries:: 220; Paper entries: 440. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either the online or paper limit accordingly. No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS AWARDS AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:
First Place *Blue*
Second Place *Red*
Third Place *Yellow*
Fourth Place *White*
Qualifying Score *Dark Green*

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH & PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH or PACH. Cones will be presented to those dogs attaining their MX/MXP/MXJ/MJP. Double Q ribbons will be awarded. A PAX rosette will be awarded for those achieving their PAX and title cones will be awarded for those receiving their MX, MXJ, MXP or MJP.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Peoria Obedience Training Club (POTC), Avanti's Dome and Sports Center and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Peoria Obedience Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the POTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the full amount of the entry fee paid for bitches and unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

Advance catalog sales may be ordered and prepaid on your entry form for \$6.00 A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site for a cost of \$8.00. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space: Ample crating will be directly behind the agility rings however, POTC and the Avanti's Dome will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. You can bring your equipment in through the back overhead door entrance. Those doors are to be operated by Avanti's personnel **only**. Front entry through revolving door throughout the day.

A full service food concession is available on the site. The Sports Arena asks that no food be brought into the facility. Dog treats are allowed. There are several restaurants and fast food vendors within a 3 miles driving distance. Worker coupons will be given that you can use to purchase food.

Overnight or RV Parking is available. **PLEASE NOTE:** There is **no electrical service for large motor homes** at this facility RV parking is not restricted to a particular area. Showers are not available onsite.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

Special arrangements can be made with Nancy Affolter @ bhanancy@hotmail.com to set up on Thursday, Sept. 7 2017. You must contact her to make arrangements.

The building will be open to exhibitors 6:30 am Friday 9/9/16, Self-service check in will begin at 7:00 all days. Class judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 AM. **Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.** There will be one half hour difference in start time between rings. This set of trials uses electronic timers.

Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and back of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted. Online entries at www.LabTestedOnline.com are accepted.

POTC and Avanti's Dome & Sports Center will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the trial buildings or on the grounds of the Avanti's Dome & Sports Center. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.

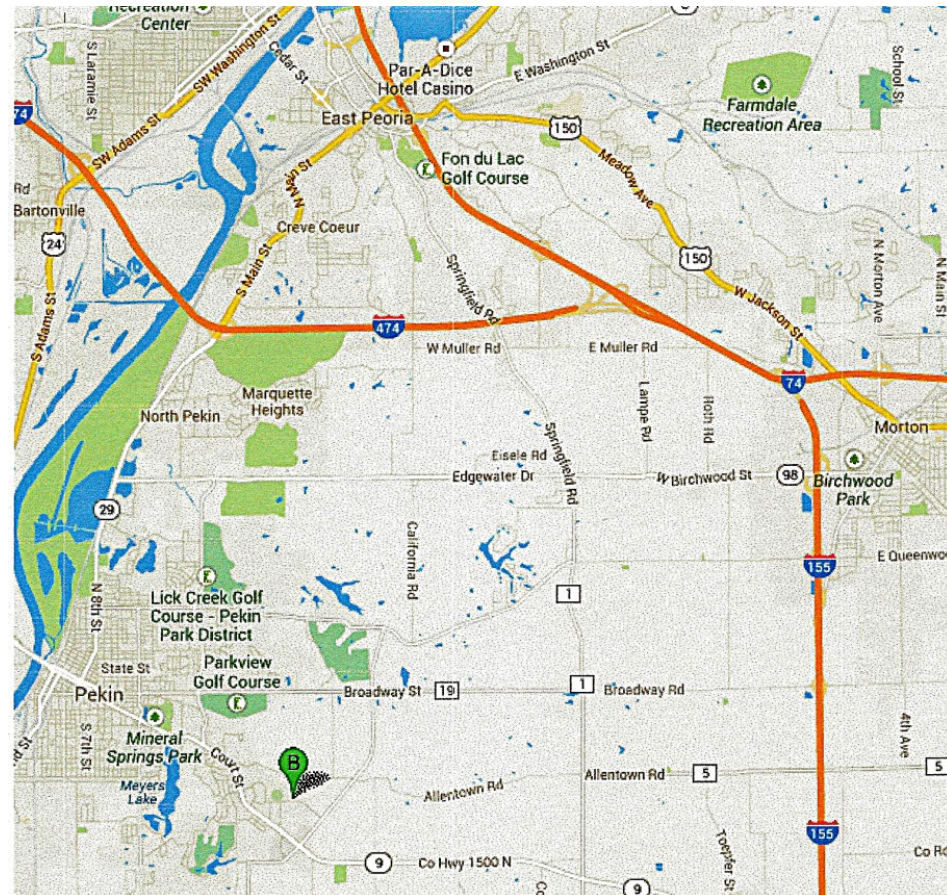

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
