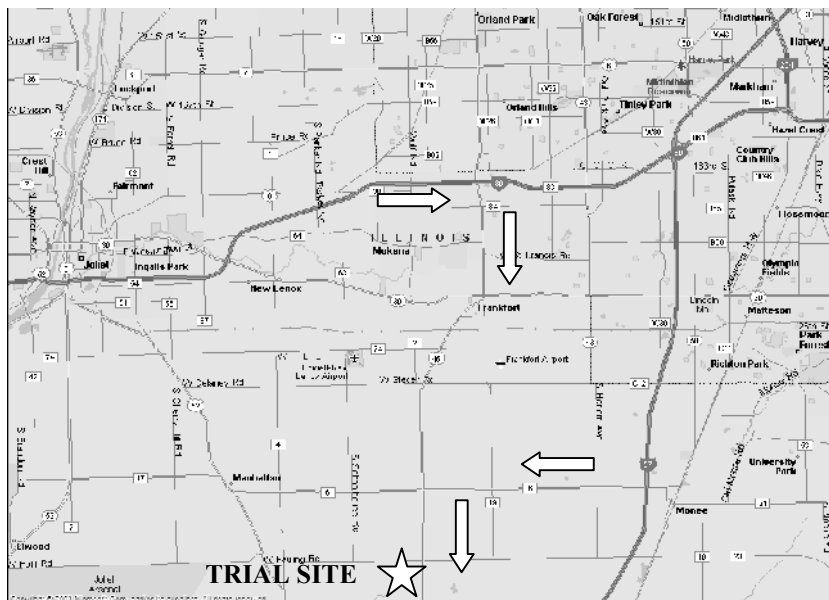

Directions to Rush'N' Around Agility Center:

From **I-294 or 94**: exit at I-80 west to I-57 south. Stay on I-57 south for 9.5 miles to the Manhattan-Monee Rd. (Rt. 6) exit and go west. Stay on Manhattan-Monee Rd. west for 6.5 miles and turn south (left) at Rt. 45 (stop sign with flashing light). Continue 2.5 miles south to Trial Site on the west side of Rt. 45. Look for agility trial signs.

From the South: Take I-57 north and exit Manhattan-Monee Rd. Then follow directions above.

The easiest route for those taking the I-355 extension is I-355 south to I-80 east. Exit Route 45 south (about 9 miles) to trial site.



HOTEL INFORMATION: Exhibitors **must** contact motels directly and identify themselves as having dogs. Some require deposits; others take only small dogs. Please use extreme caution in the treatment of motel space.

Site Information One ring, 70' x 115' indoors on sand & rubber mulch mix; Building is heated with washrooms.

Crates, tents etc may be left overnight. No dogs may be left overnight. The American Lhasa Apso Club, Inc. and the Rush 'N' Around Agility and Obedience Center will not be responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property.

Food Food will be not be available at these trials. There are several fast food restaurants within 10 minutes of the trial site.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show site clean. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs will be excused from the trial with no monies refunded.

Prizes and Awards Rosettes and plush, squeaky dog toys (valued at \$1.00 - \$3.00) will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each class.. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to place. MACH Ribbons and bars will be awarded. All prizes must be claimed before the close of the trials. None will be mailed.

Classes **STD, JWW and F.A.S.T. Classes** offered as described in Chapter 2, Section 1, "Classes" in the Agility Regulations. **No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope.** No online entries will be accepted. Express Mail entries (although not necessary) must waive "acceptance signature requirement". Entry form changes, corrections or cancellations must be done in writing before the **January 26, 2011** closing date. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms. Entries must include the AKC agreement.

Dogs Eligible to Enter This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Wait List ALAC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing at 6:00 pm on, January 26, 2011. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 7, 2011 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 7, 2011 will not be charged. If you wish to be placed on the Wait List, please mark the top of the entry form.

Catalogs Pre-order-\$7.50 each. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase (\$10.00) at the site. Running Order sheets will be available free to all exhibitors.

Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class as directed by the judge to plan their strategy. Judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm up jump will be provided for each ring.

Measuring and Height Card Information Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, **this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form.** When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the ***Dogs To Be Measured List***.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Height Divisions Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs without a valid height card.

Dogs **may not** enter both **Regular** and **Preferred** classes for the same set of trials for the weekend.

Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division but not in a division lower than their proper height. Dogs that run in a division lower than their proper height will be eliminated. Preferred dogs must run at their measured height.

Ringside Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Gate Stewards are only following directions to keep the trial moving smoothly for all. Please treat all volunteers working this trial for you with respect.

Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this, Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Single copies of the latest edition of the rules may be obtained without charge from the AKC® 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390a; also available online at www.akc.org.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Liability No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Vet or judge or barred from the competition by act of the Trial Committee. No refunds are offered for sick or injured dogs or handlers.

Collars At the handler's option the dog may wear a FLAT or rolled leather collar but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise on collars. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy collars, Halties and Gentle leaders are prohibited. Food, toys and whistles or other training devices are not allowed in the course area.

Leashes All dogs must be on leash (with the leash in owner's or handler's hand; not dragging on the ground) **at all times** except when in the Ring or when in designated Agility warm up areas. Flexi leads are not recommended in crating or course area.

Refunds No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Vet or judge or barred from the competition by act of the Trial Committee. No refunds are offered for sick or injured dogs or handlers.

Withdrawals For bitches that come into season after the closing date, the entry fee less \$10.00 per day will be refunded if a letter from Veterinarian is received by 8:00 am on the first day of the trial.

Obstacles Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility

Move Ups Dogs finishing the requirements for a title may move up to the next level of competition in accordance with AKC Agility rules. Day to day move ups will be allowed. Pre-trial move ups must be made in writing to the Trial Secretary no later than 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 7, 2011 and day to day move-ups by the close of Friday's trial for the Saturday trial and by the close of Saturday's trial for the Sunday trial. Close of the trial will be considered when the ribbons have been awarded for the last class of the day. Verbal requests will not be accepted. Move up forms will also be available at the trial. AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2011. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event, and further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above on this entry form. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. This entry is submitted for acceptance on the foregoing representation and Agreement.
