Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered. If applicable, limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard. Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries.**

"After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (25 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on August 15. The waiting list will be active until its deadline—Monday, August 29, 6:00pm CDT. Any dogs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

Obstacles

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Rubberized contacts will be used in the Standard and JWW classes. 24" weaves will be used at this trial.

Classes Offered and Limits

Entries are limited to 660 runs on Sunday and limited to 330 runs on Monday.

Sunday - - All FAST, Standard, and JWW classes, Time 2 Beat (regular and preferred). Monday - - All FAST, Standard, and JWW classes (regular and preferred).

Please consult AKC rules and regulations pertaining to Agility Trials for complete description and eligibility for entry in these classes.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class/division.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Move-Ups

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing (email ok) no later than 6:00 pm on Monday, August 29, 2011. Move-ups for Monday, Sept. 5, 2011 must be given to the Trial Secretary prior to the awards presentation of the last class on Sunday, Sept. 4, 2011.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height divisions. Judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in the trial. Height divisions are as follows:

AKC Jump Height Cards – NOTE NEW RULES EFFECTIVE 01/01/10

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs **except those jumping 24" or 26" (unless a VMO or AKC representative is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards must be measured.

You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement. If your dog does not have a valid height card for a trial and is not measured by a VMO, if present, any qualifying runs earned will be disallowed.

Prizes and Awards

Standard, JWW, FAST, and Time 2 Beat:

Qualifying ribbons and toys valued at \$1 - \$5 will be awarded to all dogs qualifying in each jump height class. Rosettes will be awarded for $1^{\text{st}} - 4^{\text{th}}$ place finishes in each jump height class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New Title ribbons will also be awarded to dogs finishing a new title at these trials. MACH, PACH, PAX and FAST Century ribbons and bars will be awarded to any dogs finishing a MACH, PACH, PAX or FAST Century title at these trials.

Notice to Exhibitors

- *The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- *It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, will be asked to leave the trial site. In such case no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- *No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the trial committee.
- *All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- *Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.
- *Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies <u>and must include the signed Agreement and Rules.</u> <u>Junior Handlers</u> must complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on form.

*Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$10 returned check fee.

- *Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- *Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in this trial. The club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.
- *Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee or the judge.
- *The club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured or ill dogs.</u> Written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary Prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.
- *Dogs under 6 months of age are not allowed on the show grounds.
- *Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- *All owners of mixed breed dogs must first obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC Agility event. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "Mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid. The dog's listing number must be entered on the entry form and "AKC No." checked.
- *Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.
- *Capitol Canine Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.



If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
