**ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.**

**Online entries** will be accepted through Lab Tested Online. Go to [www.LabTestedOnline.com](http://www.LabTestedOnline.com). Create a user account and add your dogs. Then look for the trial on your My Local Events page or search by state. Click on the "I" information icon to the right of the club's name to create your entry. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 100 online entries and 250 paper entries). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

**Wait List:** TBAC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 10 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including those on the wait list must be received by the closing date. Any withdrawn entries received by **6pm on the Monday before the trial**, will be replaced by a wait list entry, if available. Then a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait list entries that remain, will receive a refund (trial secretary will shred entry & check).

**ENTRIES FOR MIXED JUMP HEIGHTS OR CLASSES**

Entries for a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend must be submitted as separate entry forms thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

**For Exhibition Only (FEO)** will be offered at this trial in all classes.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date & pay class entry fee(s). FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

**HANDLER MUST DECLARE FEO TO THE JUDGE, WHEN ENTERING THE RING.**

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

### **RIBBONS**

Rosettes will be awarded in each class for placements 1 through 4 in each jump height . You must qualify in order to receive a placement ribbon. Qualifying green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score.

A bar and Rosette will also be awarded for any team earning their **Master Agility Championship** and **Preferred Agility Championship** at the Tampa Bay Agility Club trial. Any team earning their **PAX** Title at the TBAC trial will receive a Rosette Title Ribbon.

**DOUBLE Q** Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs that qualify in the Master Standard & JWW classes on the same day at our trial.

Title Ribbons will be available to dogs obtaining their title.

Additionally the CFTFTC will be offering HIT award for the top TFT and the top preferred TFT.

### **Move-Ups**

**MOVE-UPS:** Dogs may be moved up at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to **the Trial Secretary in writing**. (E-Mail is acceptable) All move-ups must be received by the Trial Secretary **no later than 6PM on the Monday before the trial**. Day-to-day move-ups over the weekend will be accepted but must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event (by the end of that day's trial).

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

**TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted and **WILL BE RETURNED**.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE** and **WILL BE RETURNED!**

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, It is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to Judging.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** Upon receipt of a written statement postmarked before the date of the show, a refund will be made minus a \$8.00 per day processing fee.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS** must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.

**EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.**

**All dogs 15 months of age or older** that are registered with the AKC, or that have AKC Limited Registration, ILP or PAL, or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to enter this trial.

**DOGS UNDER 4 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.**

**Obstacles** will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials. Electronic timing equipment will be used at this trial.

### **Classes Offered:**

Novice A & B, Open, Excellent & Master Regular as well as Novice Preferred, Open Preferred, Excellent Preferred & Master Preferred in both Standard and Jumpers w/Weaves and FAST Classes are offered at this trial. T2B regular and preferred classes are also offered at this trial.

Fix and Go is available to use. FEO is offered in all classes.

### **HEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

In Preferred classes a dog **MUST** jump 4 inches lower than regular height. In **REGULAR** classes **Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in regular classes** but not in a division lower than their proper height division. **Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
